VETERAN'S LICENSE TO PEDDLE OR SOLICIT TRADE

To all to Whom these Presents shall Come, Greeting:

Know Ye, that Frank P. Jones, a resident of the County of New York, State of New York, having presented to me a certificate of Honorable Discharge from the United States Army Service of the United States, dated Sept 7, 1964, and having filed the statement required by law, I hereby certify him to be entitled to the benefits of Section 32, General Business Law, entitled "Licenses to veterans of the armed forces of the United States," and he is licensed to hawk, peddle, vend and sell goods, wares and merchandise or to solicit trade upon the streets and highways within the City of New York, as in said law provided.

The holder of this license shall be subject to the ordinances, by-laws and regulations of the City of New York and to federal and state statutes and regulations.
